Explanation of Responses:

3. Following the transactions reported on this Form 4, Mr. Silitch continues to hold 12,220 shares directly and 358 shares indirectly in a 401(k) account. Mr. Silitch also holds an additional 32,313 vested stock options, 54,656 unvested stock options, and 25,389 target performance shares (the exact number awarded being dependent on achievement of performance goals).
4. Amount reported has been adjusted to include 78 shares of Issuer common stock acquired by the reporting person under The Prudential Employee Savings Plan between December 31, 2015 and September 30, 2016 based on a plan statement dated September 30, 2016. The acquisition of such shares was exempt from Section 16 pursuant to Rules 16b-3(c) and 16a-3(f)(1)(i)(B).
5. The options vested in three equal annual installments beginning on September 15, 2011.
6. The options vest in three equal annual installments beginning on February 12, 2014.
