Explanation of Responses:

1. Shares awarded by the Compensation Committee upon attainment of an average Return On Equity (ROE) of at least 13% and Compounded Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) in Earnings Per Share (EPS) of at least 12% over the 2005 through 2007 performance period based on after-tax adjusted operating income of the financial services businesses.

2. Represents shares withheld for the payment of taxes.

3. Beneficial ownership includes shares acquired under The Prudential Employee Savings Plan which are exempt transactions pursuant to Rules 16b-3(c) and 16a-3(f)(1)(i)(B).

4. The reporting person disclaims beneficial ownership of these securities, and this report shall not be deemed an admission the reporting person is the beneficial owner of such securities for the purposes of Section 16 or for any other purpose.

5. The option vests in three equal annual installments beginning on February 12, 2009.

6. The Performance Shares convert to common stock on a 1 to 1 basis.

7. Represents the target number of shares to be received upon attainment of an average Return On Equity (ROE) of 16% and Compounded Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) in Earnings Per Share (EPS) of 13% over the 2008 through 2010 performance period. Both the ROE and EPS targets are based on after-tax adjusted operating income for the financial services businesses, normalized for significant one-time benefits or charges that do not accurately reflect the operating performance of the Company's businesses in the judgment of the Compensation Committee. Attainment of 17% average ROE and EPS growth of 16% would result in an award of 150% of target. No award would be earned if average ROE is 11% or less and EPS growth is 6% or less. The actual number of shares to be received will be determined by the Compensation Committee in February 2011.
